Mint-scented. For walls, equipment hard inanimate environmental surfaces. May be used with automatic floor scrubbing equipment for disinfectant-clean floors.

GERMICIDAL DETERGENT

An EPA registered disinfectant. Effective against AIDS (HIV-1), Herpes Simplex Types 1 & 2, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Salmonella choleraesuis, Staphylococcus aureus, as well as canine distemper, feline leukemia. Also, an effective fungicide.

CONCENTRATED

Concentrated for economy. It mixes with water to make a clear solution. Neutral pH, will not harm floor finishes. When used as directed it is non-corrosive and non-staining on painted surfaces plastic tile, glass and most metal surfaces.

MILDEW CONTROL

Use on enamel, porcelain, tile, and plastics to control mildew. An ideal cleaner for walls, floors, and industrial work areas, garbage cans and trucks, industrial waste receptacle. Effective in cellars and basements.

DESCRIPTION

Sparkling clear and disinfectant clean! That is the results obtained with this disinfectant/detergent. It is a broad spectrum bactericide effective against a wide variety of gram positive and gram negative microorganisms. An excellent medium duty cleaner safe for use on all washable surfaces. A neutral pH makes it perfect for damp mopping floor finishes without dulling them.

APPLICATION

For disinfecting, deodorizing and cleaning nonporous inanimate surfaces

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DISINFECTION - To disinfect hard, inanimate surfaces apply solution so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then remove excess liquid. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

GENERAL DISINFECTION - Add 2 ounces of this product per gallon of water.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION - Add 3 ounces of this product per gallon of water.

To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet, add 2 oz. of this product directly to the bowl water. Swab the bowl completely. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

MILDEWSTAT - To control mold and mildew clean surfaces then add 2 oz. of this product per gallon of water. Apply, making sure to wet surfaces completely. Let air dry.
